

#### The strong deflector elbow

For the gentle deflection of pneumatically conveyed, dense phase, abrasive bulk materials. Effective material stream guidance, optimal wall thickness, and high strength cast steel guarantee extremely long service lives.

#### Areas of application:

The FLOW-BOW elbow serves to deflect dry, nonclodding bulk material with a highly wear-resistant system around corners in dense phase material conveying pipelines. Areas of application are mainfold: From powdery and splintery materials to highly abrasive bulk materials, e.g. quartz sand, shotcrete, basalt chips as well as for cocoa husks and even applications in animal carcass rendering plants. For application in the plastics- and foodstuffs industries special cast stainless steel (1.4408) models are available.




The FLOW-BOW is designed so that a cushion of material forms at the deflection site when bulk goods are being conveyed. At this point the bulk goods are deflected with little abrasion. At the end of conveying this material cushion is purged completely with the final surge.






90° and 135° elbow, special sizes on request.





The illustration shows the wall thicknesses and the material cushion in the FLOW-BOW during dense phase conveying; the optimal protection against abrasion is therefore obtained for the deflection of bulk goods.
